Many genetic testing labs employ genetic counselors to analyze data and communicate results to patients and ordering providers




CARDIOLOGY

Genetic counseling can help determine if genetic testing could be beneficial and provide guidance on test results for people with a personal or family history of cardiovascular conditions.

OPTHAMOLOGY

Genetic counseling for eye diseases can help interpret genetic mutations and clarify the risk of individuals inheriting certain vision diseases. They can also help confirm a vision-related diagnosis, provide information about treatment options, and guide families in making informed decisions.
